The flexibility offered with the *ddR*Aura solutions, including the U-arm design on the *ddR*Aura U, was the perfect solution for busy imaging centers like The CORE Institute, who demand the most from its digital radiography solutions.

A good design and an intuitive user interface are paramount when considering the investment being made. The *ddR*Aura U-arm design, paired with an Automatic Positioning System (APS), a small handheld remote control, and an optional foot pedal for effortless positioning, are critical components for a busy orthopedic practice to optimize workflow. The automatic single-focus stitching option combines multiple images into one image quickly and easily for scoliosis and leg length studies. Additionally, improved flexibility enables precise positioning adjustments and increases the quality of care of all patients while ensuring the physical health of radiographic technologists.

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As a practice, we are very happy with our decision to stay with Swissray and to add additional DR systems to our existing inventory.
